Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The Christ Church Choir is happy to announce its second-ever **HYMN-A-THON**, to be held on **Saturday, January 29**, between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Members of our Choir will spend the day singing one verse of as many hymns in *The Hymnal 1982* as possible. Those who complete the full nine hours will sing one verse each of seven hundred twenty hymns!

All of you are invited to sing that day, too. (we hope you will!) or to **support our Youth Choir with a donation.** This event will benefit our Youth Choir tour fund, especially supporting a trip to England this coming summer. Our boys and girls will be in residence at Durham Cathedral from August 8-14, singing services there nearly every day. The children need to raise money to provide scholarships for youth choristers who require them and to help provide support staff for the trip.

Our Hymn-a-thon in January will consist of three components:

- 1) The boys, girls, and anyone else who would like to join us, will collect **sponsors to pledge so-much-per-hymn.** Each singer will strive for his or her personal best in singing as many hymns as possible, the goal being to go the distance and sing the entire book. Please don't be surprised when some enterprising young chorister or old organist approaches you to invite your sponsorship.
- 2) During December, our parish held a **Primary Election** to determine a short list of our **congregation's favorite hymns.** On the day of the Hymn-a-thon we will use this list to vote for Christ Church's #1 favorite hymn. Voting in the Primary Election was one person, one vote. Voting on the day of the Hymn-a-thon will be "Chicago style," with each vote costing a dollar. The winning hymn will be featured on the Sunday following the Hymn-a-thon.
- 3) If you wish to hear your favorite hymn sung in a particular way on the day of the Hymn-a-thon (with a descant, a soloist, boys only, girls only, singers over or under 50 only, etc.), you may place an order for a **Designer Hymn from our Hymns-R-Us department.** Please contact the Music Office for more information (847-446-2850, ext. 22).

Our Youth Choir and Tour Committee appreciate your support! Please consider joining us on January 29 to praise God by singing and listening to the great hymns of the Church.
