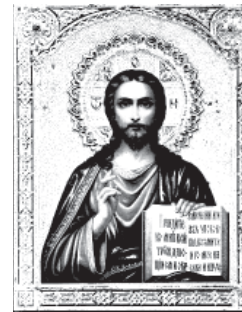
SUNDAY FORUMS
